

1 HARDWARE

1.2.1 Printers



Epson TM T88Vi (Serial, USB)

It can also be wall mounted using an optional bracket to further save space. Samsung Bixolono SRP-275II (Serial, USB)



1.2.2 **Cash Drawers**




Posiflex CR6300 (Printer kick, Serial)


